# 🍀 Our Values

At Coventry Swim School, we believe every swimmer deserves a fun, safe, and supportive environment to learn and grow. This Code of Conduct sets out the behaviour we expect from all our swimmers—both in and out of the water.

## What We Expect from You

## • Respect Others

- Be kind and respectful to other swimmers, swimming teachers, and staff.
- Listen carefully and follow instructions at all times.
- Treat everyone equally—no teasing, bullying, or exclusion.

#### Try Your Best

- Always give your best effort in the pool.
- Be on time and ready for your lesson.
- Bring the right kit, including swimwear, towel, goggles, and swim cap if needed.

#### Stay Safe

- Walk, don't run, around the pool area.
- Keep your hands and feet to yourself—no pushing, splashing, or rough play.
- Never go into the water without a swimming teacher's permission.
- Use the changing rooms responsibly and respect others' privacy.

#### • Be a Team Player

- Support and encourage other swimmers.
- Share space in the water and take turns.
- Celebrate others' progress as well as your own.

#### Look After Your Environment

- Take care of your belongings and respect school property.
- Put rubbish in the bins and leave the changing room tidy.
- Treat pool facilities and equipment with care.

#### 🚫 What's Not Allowed

- Swearing, shouting, or using unkind language.
- Using phones, cameras, or other devices in changing rooms or poolside.
- Ignoring instructions or disrupting lessons.





• Physical or verbal bullying of any kind.

## 📌 If Rules Are Broken

#### If any part of this Code of Conduct is broken:

- 1. You may be given a warning.
- 2. Your parent or guardian may be informed.
- 3. You may be asked to leave the pool or sit out a session.
- 4. Serious or repeated behaviour could result in being suspended or removed from the swim school.
